<sup>16</sup> So it came about on the third day, when it was morning, that there were thunder and lightning flashes and a thick cloud upon the mountain and a very loud trumpet sound, so that all the people who were in the camp trembled. <sup>17</sup> And Moses brought the people out of the camp to meet G-d, and they stood at the foot of the mountain.

<sup>18</sup> Now Mount Sinai was all in smoke because the L-rd descended upon it in fire; and its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mountain quaked violently. <sup>19</sup> When the sound of the trumpet grew louder and louder, Moses spoke and G-d answered him with thunder. <sup>20</sup> The L-rd came down on Mount Sinai, to the top of the mountain; and the L-rd called Moses to the top of the mountain, and Moses went up.

<sup>33</sup> He erected the court all around the tabernacle and the altar, and hung up the veil for the gateway of the court.
