I. THE RESURRECTION IS A NEW CONDITION

I. THE RESURRECTION IS A NEW <u>CONDITION</u> A. IT IS NOT A <u>RESTORATION</u>

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Luke 7:12-13

¹² Now as He approached the gate of the city, a dead man was being carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow; and a sizeable crowd from the city was with her. ¹³ When the L-rd saw her, He felt compassion for her, and said to her, "Do not weep."
