The Most Sacred Place

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The <u>TEMPLE</u> Mount is the most <u>SACRED</u> place in Israel because it is where G-d's glory <u>DWELT</u>, Messiah <u>SERVED</u>, and G-d's glory will RETURN.

- A. G-d spoke to <u>ABRAHAM</u> about it.

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- ¹ Now it came about after these things, that G-d tested Abraham, and said to him,
- "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am.

- D. G-d's glory <u>DESCENDED</u> on it I Kings 8:10-13
- ¹⁰ It happened that when the priests came from the holy place, the cloud filled the house of the L-rd, ¹¹ so that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud, for the glory of the L-rd filled the house of the L-rd.

- F. G-d's glory <u>DEPARTED</u> from it. Ezekiel 10:3-4
- ³ Now the cherubim were standing on the right side of the temple when the man entered, and the cloud filled the inner court.

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B. All <u>NATIONS</u> will <u>WORSHIP</u> in this place. Zechariah 14:16-17

16 Then it will come about that any who are left of all the nations that went against Jerusalem will go up from year to year to worship the King, the L-rd of hosts, and to celebrate the Feast of Booths.
